## Dear Resident

Following our public exhibition in the summer where we showed our new proposals for the Ram Brewery site in a draft format, I would like to invite you to attend a further exhibition to see how our plans have developed into a planning application.

Thank you to those who attended our exhibition and completed our questionnaire. It is clear to us from the results of that survey, that regenerating Wandsworth Town Centre is regarded as a major benefit of redeveloping the historic brewery site. At the same time, we understand that we must respond to issues of sensitive design, preserving the brewery heritage, creating a pedestrian friendly environment and responding to transport issues.

Our proposals for a mixed use development would create around 460 residential apartments, preserve the heritage buildings on site, open up access to the River Wandle, attract high quality retail to the town centre and create over 1000 jobs; helping to regenerate Wandsworth Town Centre is central to all our plans.
